Snow Update 3/7/2013 12:00 PM

I normally don't send out updates this far before the storm, but this forecast is unusual. The National Weather Service already has a 90% chance rating 36 hours before the event. We'll keep our eye on it. The good news for commuters is, it's over the weekend. The bad news is Saturday will be very messy. WINTER STORM WATCH IN EFFECT FROM LATE FRIDAY NIGHT THROUGH SATURDAY EVENING...

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN DENVER HAS ISSUED A WINTER STORM WATCH...WHICH IS IN EFFECT FROM LATE FRIDAY NIGHT THROUGH SATURDAY EVENING.

\* TIMING...SNOW WILL BEGIN OVER THE URBAN CORRIDOR PLAINS BY MID FRIDAY EVENING...THEN OVER THE REST OF THE PLAINS AROUND MIDNIGHT. MODERATE TO HEAVY SNOW IS POSSIBLE FROM AROUND 6 AM MST SATURDAY MORNING INTO SATURDAY EVENING.

\* SNOW ACCUMULATIONS...WILL RANGE FROM 7 TO 12 INCHES POSSIBLE. THE MOST IS EXPECTED OVER THE FRONT RANGE URBAN CORRIDOR
