Snow Update 3/22/2013 6:00 AM

It looks like another typical spring storm is on its way. This is more great news for our lawns, trees, and shrubs. It is also snowing hard in the mountains, great for our snowpack and summer water situation. But will also cause some inconveniences over the next few days.

These spring events have their own challenges. Like the last few storms, temperatures will start out relatively warm. We are expecting rain to begin mid day and continue into this evening. That rain will turn to wet snow. By tonight, the wet snow will freeze and new snow will accumulate on top. This makes removal very difficult. Snow blowers will again be ineffective in the slushy snow. We also expect to use a lot of ice melt. We have added staff and stockpiled ice melt for the storm. Some sites prefer to forego the expense, mess, and possible damage caused by ice melting products. If you have already notified us of this preference, you may wish to re-consider for this storm. It is expected to snow continuously through Sunday. Also, it will be very cold. We may not see melting begin until Wednesday. It will be icy beginning tonight.
