Snow Update 3/23/2013 8:00 AM

The snow didn't accumulate enough to trigger services until about 3:00 AM this morning. We began operations at that time.

The local news is measuring 7" downtown and in the suburbs. Snowfall is not expected to diminish until sundown. Total accumulation will be over 10". Strong winds from the north are causing blizzard conditions.

Our plan for the blizzard is to service every site once during the day today. We'll break for food and a change of clothes then return for another round overnight. This will be ideal if forecasts are correct and the snow stops at sundown. That should get everyone taken care of by sunrise Sunday.

The unknown factor is the wind. The forecast is for the wind to stop at sundown. If it blows overnight, we will have to do another round during the day on Sunday.

There is another storm forecast for mid-day Sunday lasting into the Monday rush hour. Because of its timing, this one could be more difficult to manage.
