Snow Update 11/30/2011 7:30

There is a 90% chance of snow by midnight tonight. Total accumulations are predicted to be 3" to 6". We spent the afternoon preparing equipment and are ready to go. As always, we are staffed to be able to clear snow within 8 hours of your specified accumulation amount and then at 12 hour intervals for the duration the storm.

Unfortunately, snow accumulation looks to be timed to trigger removal services right around daybreak. So for the third storm in a row, we will have a messy morning rush hour. Traffic will delay our movements along our routes. Pedestrians and vehicles will pack what snow has fallen.

We expect high winds along with the storm. We will monitor conditions as necessary.

We will have crew leaders driving around the city and inspecting accumulations throughout the night.
